Located in the heart of Old Quebec, a world heritage fortified city, the School of Architecture is housed in the oldest educational buildings in Canada. With a unique focus on design and research, combining an involvement with collectivities, the School of Architecture is recognized for the quality of its educational programs and the originality of its contribution to forwarding the architectural profession.

The Position and its Characteristics

The School of Architecture seeks candidate whose expertise and experience intersects one (or several) of the three following areas of teaching, research and creation:

1. **Person-environment studies and intercultural collaborations**, covering for instance the human aspects of architecture and the city, architectural and urban programming, as well as culturally appropriate collaborative and participatory design methods.
2. **Digital fabrication and design media**, including for instance innovative digital modes of architectural representation, the use of computer-assisted fabrication and design, interactive design and media, as well as the relationship between the digital and the analogue.
3. **Energy efficiency and simulation**, addressing for instance technical relationships to building and construction (passive and renewable energy, envelope, environmental systems, ecological materials, etc.).

The review of applications will take into account the quality of the application and the relevancy of research interests, the capacity to develop university level instruction in the form of design studios, courses, seminars and individual mentoring of both graduate and post-graduate students (thesis advising), in addition to the quality of proposed or built architectural work presented.

Candidates must be prepared to teach at undergraduate, graduate and post-graduate levels and to be actively engaged in innovative research in one or several of the three areas described above. A professional degree in architecture and a completed or nearly completed doctoral degree (or sufficient documentation meriting equivalency) are required. Professional experience in architecture would be highly valued. Candidates should be fluent in French or have a functional knowledge and a commitment to reaching fluency quickly.

Applications should submit: a letter of intent; Curriculum Vitae including a list of publications, scientific communications, exhibitions, scholarships and research grants, prizes and distinctions; a portfolio illustrating professional design work, research projects and university level teaching experience; as well as a list of three references.
